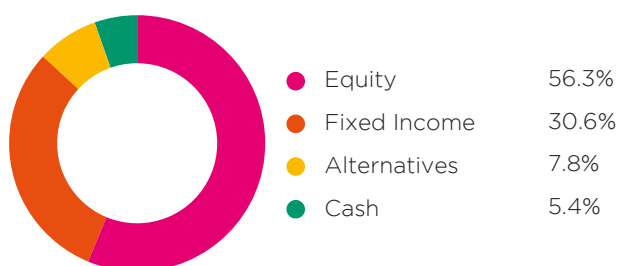

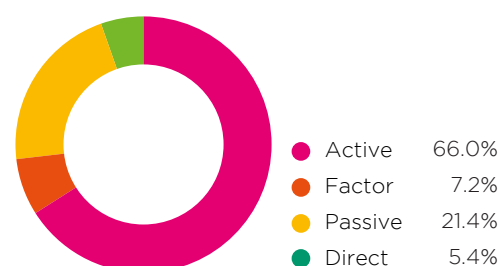

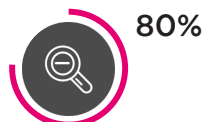

NEGATIVE SCREENING



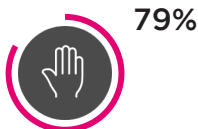

Investments selected for positive ESG performance relative to peers. e.g. environmental protection or human rights.

STEWARDSHIP & VOTING



Use of shareholder power to influence corporate behaviour.

THEMATIC



Investment in themes related to sustainability issues. e.g. addressing social or environmental challenges.

IMPACT INVESTING



Investment with the intention to generate social and environmental impact.

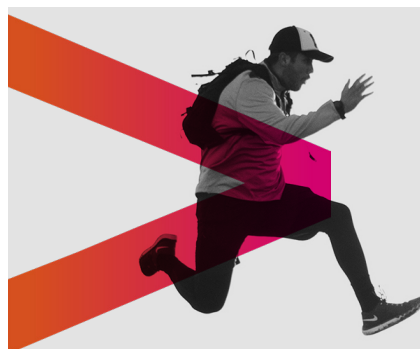

In this way, we not only take full responsibility for the holdings within our portfolios but also factor the sustainability exposure that they deliver.

We acknowledge that such outcomes are not always easy to understand, so we contextualise this data through real-world examples so that our investors can fully appreciate the lower carbon-exposure of their portfolio.

*Savings measured in tonnes of CO2e per £1M invested based on Scope 1 & 2 financed emissions calculated using PCAF (Partnership for Carbon Accounting Financials) methodology. Data obtained when comparing Pacific's portfolio versus an equivalent portfolio from an asset allocation perspective populated with benchmark holdings. When utilising this measure, we do not cover the entire portfolio (government bonds, cash, and holdings without available emissions data are excluded from the calculation).
